1. Attend 15 clock hours of sessions.

In addition to regular sessions, you may count concerts, banquets (if there is a program and a speaker), divisional business meetings, and exhibit time viewing curricular materials.

2. Keep a diary of the events you attend. Provide me with a document that includes a BRIEF 3-4 sentence summation of each event you attend. (REQUIRED) Because of the re-organization of the fee structure for this year's course, there will be no faculty response to the document you present.

3. **In order for your transcript to be sent to your State Department of Education, a written request must be sent directly to the Office of Academic Records, Furman University, 3300 Poinsett Highway, Greenville, SC, 29613. There is no fee for this transcript service.**
